

DID YOU KNOW

- Nearly 60% of NYC's homeless population live in Manhattan.

› Last year, HFNY gave over \$250,000 in grants that provided direct relief and services to the homeless in Manhattan.

- 62% of NYC residents with household incomes below \$25,000 experienced difficulty affording food.

› HFNY's grants supported multiple food programs, including The Father's Heart Ministries, which provided warm meals to 25,000 New Yorkers.

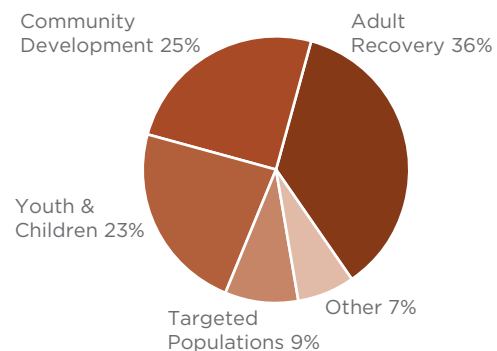
We currently support organizations that serve various populations including inner-city youth, low-income families, the homeless, seniors, immigrants and those living with HIV/AIDS.

HFNY'S IMPACT

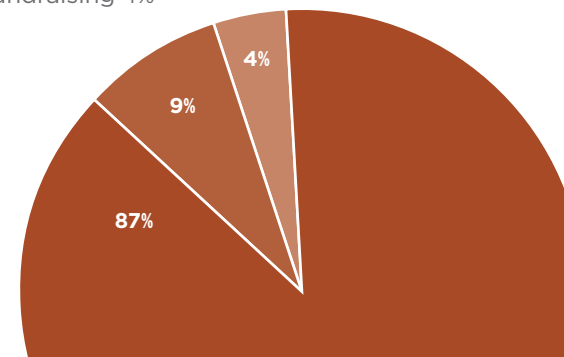
In FY 2010, HFNY distributed over \$1 million in grants and over 35,000 volunteer hours (worth over \$1M in labor¹) to 30+ affiliates.

- **\$100** can provide nutritious meals to 60 homeless individuals
- **\$250** can help support the mentoring of 8 inner-city high school students
- **\$500** can provide medical and optometric care to 25 homeless patients
- **\$1,000** can purchase dictionaries for 100+ immigrant students preparing for the GED
