HFNY'S IMPACT

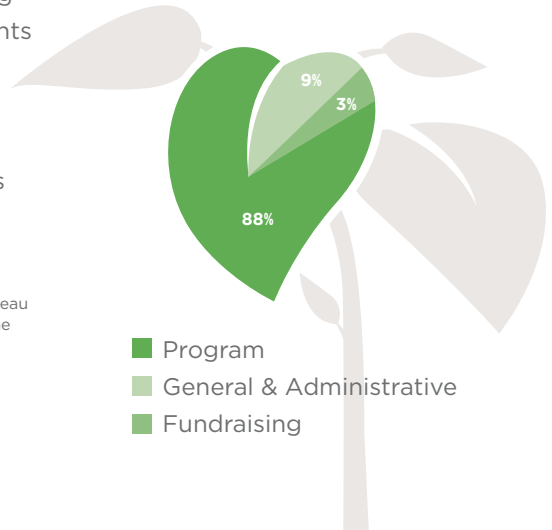
In FY 2009, HFNY contributed **\$894,454** in grants (31% increase) and **41,000+** volunteer hours (worth \$1.08M in labor⁽¹⁾) to 30+ affiliates in the areas of Adult Recovery, Community Development, Youth and Children, and Targeted Populations.
